4 **ORDINANCE 2025-2**

5 AN ORDINANCE CREATING SECTIONS 382.504 (COUNCIL  
6 APPROVAL OF SOLID WASTE ASSESSMENT REDUCTIONS),  
7 382.505 (CITY'S OBLIGATION TO FUND SOLID WASTE  
8 ASSESSMENT REDUCTIONS) AND 382.506 (EFFECTIVE  
9 DATE), PART 5 (SOLID WASTE SERVICE FEE), CHAPTER  
10 382 (WASTE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL SERVICE BY  
11 CONTRACTORS AND CITY), *ORDINANCE CODE*, TO  
12 ESTABLISH REDUCTIONS FOR SOLID WASTE  
13 ASSESSMENTS; REQUESTING COORDINATION WITH THE  
14 CITY OF ATLANTIC BEACH, THE CITY OF NEPTUNE  
15 BEACH, THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE BEACH AND THE  
16 TOWN OF BALDWIN; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION  
17 INSTRUCTIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

19 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

20 **Section 1. Creating new Sections 382.504 (Council Approval**  
21 **of Solid Waste Assessment Reductions), 382.505 (City's Obligation to**  
22 **Fund Solid Waste Assessment Reductions) and 382.506 (Effective Date),**  
23 **Part 5 (Solid Waste Service Fee), Chapter 382 (Waste Collection and**  
24 **Disposal Service by Contractors and City), *Ordinance Code*.** Section  
25 382.504 (Council Approval of Solid Waste Assessment Reductions),  
26 Section 382.505 (City's Obligation to Fund Solid Waste Assessment  
27 Reductions), and Section 506 (Effective Date), Part 5 (Solid Waste  
28 Service Fee), Chapter 382 (Waste Collection and Disposal Service by  
29 Contractors and City), *Ordinance Code*, are hereby created to read as  
30 follows:

31 **CHAPTER 382 - WASTE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL SERVICE BY CONTRACTORS**



1 the Solid Waste Fund.

2 **Sec. 382.506 - Effective Date.**

3 The low-income solid waste assessment reduction set forth in  
4 section 382.504 above shall become effective and begin with the 2025  
5 calendar year assessment.

6 **Section 2. Coordination with the City of Atlantic Beach,**  
7 **the City of Neptune Beach, the City of Jacksonville Beach, and the**

8 **Town of Baldwin.** The Council requests that the Mayor and the Office  
9 of General Counsel coordinate with the City of Atlantic Beach, the  
10 City of Neptune Beach, the City of Jacksonville Beach, and the Town  
11 of Baldwin to create a process for offering a similar or substantially  
12 similar discount, reduction or reimbursement for residential garbage  
13 collection fees for low-income households in these municipalities  
14 meeting the same criteria as set forth in Section 382.504, *Ordinance*  
15 *Code*. Each program would be subject to City Council approval and then  
16 would be funded by the City as part of the annual budget process.

17 **Section 3. Codification Instructions.** The Codifier and the  
18 Office of General Counsel are authorized to make all chapter and  
19 division "tables of contents" consistent with the changes set forth  
20 herein. Such editorial changes and any other changes necessary to  
21 make the Ordinance Code consistent with the intent of this legislation  
22 are approved and directed herein, and changes to the Ordinance Code  
23 shall be made forthwith and when inconsistencies are discovered.

24 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
25 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
26 without the Mayor's signature.
