1. Electronic Communications: Emails, text messages, instant messages, direct messages, and other electronic exchanges, whether transmitted via personal, work, or third-party applications (e.g., WhatsApp, Signal, Facebook Messenger, Slack, etc.);
2. Social Media Communications: Messages, posts, comments, or replies made or received on social media platforms such as Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, LinkedIn, or any other social networking service;
3. Correspondence: Letters, faxes, memoranda, handwritten or typed notes, or other written exchanges;
4. Audio/Visual Communications: Voicemails, recorded phone calls, or video recordings of conversations, including virtual meetings conducted via platforms such as Zoom, Microsoft Teams, or similar services;
