On 3/30/2026 Det. Ellis and I attempted to make contact with the suspect at his residence, however he was not home. His mother stated [REDACTED]

While sitting in the parking lot in the apartment complex I observed the suspect pull into the property driving a large, black, Chevrolet Express van with Florida license plate BS94JZ, which is registered to Temple Christian Academy. Det. Ellis and I made contact with the suspect while he was still in the van. A black iPhone was visible in the suspect's hand. The suspect agreed to exit the vehicle and speak with us. The black iPhone was left in the vehicle. The suspect was placed in the front seat of my unmarked agency issued Ford Explorer for an [REDACTED] interview. The suspect was told he was not under arrest or detained, and he could conclude the interview if he liked. The suspect verified he was not under the influence of any impairing substance, and he did not have any impairing medical conditions.

The suspect's cell phone was left in the van in a cupholder by the driver's seat. Through the window of the vehicle in plain view, I could see the phone is a black iPhone, matching information provided through multiple subpoenas regarding the suspect numbers and accounts. The suspect's phone number was called twice and the phone in the cup holder visibly showed a missed call each time.

A search warrant (Control Number 151640) for the Chevrolet Express van was prepared and signed by Judge H. Murcia-Bustos on 3/30/2026 and the suspect's phone was retrieved from the vehicle. [REDACTED]

An additional search warrant (Control Number 151641) was prepared and signed by Judge H. Murcia-Bustos on 3/31/2026 for the suspect's phone searching for evidence related to the offenses of Transmission of Harmful Material to a Minor (F.S.S. 847.0138(2)) and Unlawful Use of a Two Way Communication Device to Facilitate a Felony (F.S.S. 934.215).

The suspect's iPhone was forensically processed by Det. Janssen. The phone is an Apple iPhone 14 Pro Max. Below is a summary of the general file information for the phone:
