**ORDER AFTER CASE MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE AND SETTING  
TEMPORARY INJUNCTION HEARING**


This matter came before this Court for a Case Management Conference on June 26, 2026, pursuant to the Order Setting Case Management Conference for Consideration of Expedited Case Scheduling, filed on June 23, 2026. The Court has reviewed the docket, heard the positions of counsel, and is advised in the premises.

1. Plaintiff challenges the inclusion of Defendant Patrick on the ballot as a Libertarian Party candidate for the City of Jacksonville City Counsel based on alleged inaccuracies that create statutory deficiencies in her qualifying papers.
2. This challenge is particularly time sensitive as the ballots for that race have already been printed and, according to counsel for the Supervisor of Elections, the first of those ballots will be mailed out starting on July 2, 2026.
3. Defendant Patrick filed a Motion to Dismiss on June 26, 2026, alleging both pleading deficiencies and alleging that election at issue is outside the scope of the statute relied

upon. Plaintiff may file its response in opposition on or before 12 noon on June 30, 2026. The Court will, thereafter, rule on the Motion to Dismiss expeditiously.

4. Recognizing the time constraints with mailing of ballots due to commence on July 2, 2026, the Court, without objection, sets the hearing on Plaintiff's requested injunctive relief for Wednesday, July 1, 2026, at 1:00 p.m. in Room 712 of the Duval County Unified Courthouse. Counsel and parties are permitted to appear via remote technology if needed at [HTTP://WWW.ZOOM.COM](http://WWW.ZOOM.COM) or <https://zoom.us/j/8768632186>; Meeting ID: 876 863 2186. Notwithstanding permitted appearances via ZOOM, this will be an evidentiary hearing, with notice, conducted pursuant to Rule 1.610(a)(2), Florida Rules of Civil Procedure.
5. Should the Court grant Defendant Patrick's Motion to Dismiss, that Order will address the status of the temporary injunction hearing.
